## BE SMART WITH MONEY

## KEEP YOUR PRIVATE INFO PRIVATE

**Never include your personal contact information in your profile.** Telephone numbers, email addresses, IM addresses, your home or work address, and your last name are all private and should stay that way!

## YOU'RE IN CONTROL WITH THE PACE

**You decide to remain anonymous until you feel ready to meet in person,** you control the pace of the relationship, and you choose when it's time to take your online relationship offline. Don't let anyone else tell you otherwise! Ask a lot of questions. Potential dates will respect your space and allow you to take your time.

## MEET IN A PUBLIC PLACE



**When you decide to meet face to face,** pick a public place and provide your own transportation to and from the location. Restaurants, coffee shops and shopping malls are good examples of public places; private homes or hotel rooms are not. Before going out on a date, always tell a friend or family member where you are going and check-in with them when you return home.
